My readings and reflections have caused me to pause and remember the many saints who labored at Trinity in the past, and those of you who are now joining efforts together today to do both large and small things in a great way. I find myself pausing each day to be thankful for our rich heritage and our current work and yet to wonder, "What is next?"

But we are also challenging ourselves to understand who we, as a community of believers, are being challenged to do in this place and at this time.

(Bishop Skirving: "When I visit here, I am always amazed at the work of this parish.") I am also hopeful because all of us, as saints of God, are rising to the challenge of doing something in a great way. I am not sure what it is for each of you, but my prayer is that together, we answer the question, "What is next?"


Altar Guild


